Strathallan School was founded in 1913 in Bridge of Allan, near Stirling, but quickly outgrew its original site. In 1920, the school moved to the Freeland Estate in Forgandenny, a few miles south east of Scotland's ancient capital the City of Perth.



Academic

Students on the course are asked to choose A Level subjects from the following options: Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Economics and Business.

There are also dedicated EAL (English as an Additional Language) classes. Throughout the course there is a firm emphasis on 'TEAP' - Teaching English for Academic Purposes. Teachers focus on the language and the techniques needed to make a successful start to A Level courses. TEAP teaching gives pupils the skills to be able to listen to extended speech and pick out key points; it also develops the ability to read and manage information in longer pieces of writing. Lessons are on weekday mornings and straight after lunch. There are a range of co-curricular activities outside those times. Students are awarded a Completion Certificate on successful completion of the course.

There are three two-week A Level Preparation Camps running in July and August. Each Camp has a full programme running Monday to Sunday, with sports and activities throughout the week and trips out on the middle Saturday and Sunday.
