A team can be made up with 3 or 4 riders (best 3 scores to count), individuals can also ride.
A horse/pony and rider combination may compete **once in a class**, and again in the **following** class.
A horse/pony may not compete in more than 2 classes.
A rider may compete more than once in a class on another horse/pony, and in the same team if necessary.

ALL TEAM COMPETITORS AUTOMATICALLY QUALIFY FOR BOTH TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL PRIZES (but only ride once).

Class 1 Teams and Individuals (55 - 60 cm)

Restriction For combinations of horse/pony and rider that have never been placed 1st at 75cm (2'6") or higher in a show jumping class, before this competition's closing date.
Any protest regarding eligibility to ride in this class must be made before the Prize Giving.

Class 2 Teams and Individuals (70-75 cm)

Restriction A combination that competes in 1m classes should not compete in this class. Any protest regarding eligibility to ride in this class must be made before the Prize Giving.

Class 3 Teams and Individuals (85-90 cm)

No restrictions

Class 4 Open Teams and Individuals (100 -105 cm)

No restrictions

This competition is being run under **Pony Club Rules**.

In each class, individuals compete after the teams have ridden, except for Class 4 when the individuals will ride first.

All classes are “Single Phase”, after a rider jumps the first section they automatically go into a second timed section, regardless of their score in the first section, unless they have been eliminated (eg. 3 refusals or 1 fall). All the fences are the same height in each class.

Rosettes

Rosettes will be awarded to the first 6 teams in each class.

Rosettes will be awarded 1st – 6th to the best individuals in each class.

Winning teams /individuals will also be presented with a sash.

Team trainer

All teams must be represented by a team trainer who will be responsible for the team being ready to compete. Any team changes must be declared before the start of the class.

RIDING HATS must comply with current safety standards – PAS015 or EN 1384 with kitemark. The competition is run under Pony Club Show Jumping rules. Stirrup Control System equipment (interlocking boots/stirrup treads) are NOT permitted to be worn at this event.

ENTRIES

Entries, which will be limited, should be emailed to Julie Summersgill and sent under one cover by the Team Manager or Individual rider. **There is no official entry form this year.**

Please state full name of rider, name of horse/pony and school or riding club (if appropriate).
