Introduction

The following lists are designed for use by Boarding pupils. Day pupils will be expected to have all uniform items, but will not be required to have some of the items only necessary for those living at the School.

Please be aware that the measurement process required for specialist fitting of items such as kilts requires touch. Our staff are trained to deliver this service properly and respectfully, so if your child has any sensory issues that might be triggered by this process, or would prefer to be measured by a parent/guardian for any reason, please do let us know at any point. The pupil's name must be marked securely with nametaps on EVERY article (including boots and shoes). For items bought through Schoolblazer, an option is available for nametapes to be automatically attached. On arrival, new pupils should give the Housematron two dozen spare nametapes. A charge will be made for any article that has to be marked at the School. It is recommended that all fabric should be of a type not liable to shrink.

All beds in boarding houses are single size. A fitted sheet and one pillow are provided by the school. All pupils will require the following:

- I Duvet*
- 2 Duvet covers*
- 2 Pillow Cases*

*If required, a bedding pack can be ordered from the school shop (must be ordered at least 30 days before joining the school). This consists of one duvet, one pillow, two duvet covers, 2 pillowcases and one fitted sheet.

Laundry

Please note: laundry is uplifted twice a week. All items on the list must be bought in order for the laundry system to function correctly.

All articles should be suitable for laundry; uniform that requires to be dry cleaned will be charged separately at the end of each term where appropriate. House washing machines are for the washing of casual clothes and underwear only. The School must advise parents not to send their children to School with duvet covers with plastic stud poppers or button fasteners. The School cannot take liability for any item of laundry which is submitted to the commercial wash with plastic items which are likely to melt. Duvet covers with velcro or tie fasteners are preferred and should not be damaged in the laundry process.

Swimmers Kit List

Competitive Swimmers

- 2 or 3 training costumes/ trunks
- 2 or 3 caps for training
- 2 pairs training goggles + I pair competition
- I race suit

Training Kit bag should include:

- Kick board
- · Training fins
- Snorkel
- Hand paddles
- Finger paddles
- Pull buoy

Competitive swimmers should have all the above where possible and training wear can be of their own choice. It is handy to have race kit in school in-case we have an interschool competition or do race practice in training.

Uniform Rules

Whether in school uniform, games or formal dress, pupils should observe the dress code. In particular:

- School Uniform -Shirts should be tucked in, top button fastened on buttoned shirts, ties done up and shoes polished.
- Formal Dress –Clothing should be clean and, where relevant, ironed. Kilt hose should be held up with garters. All members of the senior part of the School, except School Authority, must have a kilt to be worn at Chapel, Speech Day and other formal occasions. Boys in the Upper Sixth Form may wear formal trewsas an alternative (NB fashion plaid trousers are not acceptable).
- Pupils visiting other schools should wear school uniform, including blazer, unless specifically instructed otherwise.
- Pupils accompanied by staff attending medical or dental appointments in Perth may wear informal dress but must change back to weekday dress at the first practical opportunity after such an appointment.
- Games Kit should not be torn and must be clean for all School matches. Regulation shorts/skortsmust be worn, shirts tucked in and socks kept up. All members of school cricket XIs should have whites and cricket footwear. All team practices and games sessions require regulation kit. Jewellery must not be worn with games kit.
- PE Classes –Regulation shorts/skortsand polo shirt with School crest must be worn. Kit should not be torn and must be clean. Jewellery must not be worn with PE kit.
- Informal Dress should be clean and inoffensive.
- Hair should be brushed and clean, extreme styles should be avoided. It should be of a natural colour and must not be obviously dyed. Pupils breaking these rules may be asked to return home until the situation has been corrected if it is not possible to sort the problem out at school at their expense.
- Jewellery –Pupils should limit their wearing of jewellery to one pair of stud earrings only, one simple necklace, one bracelet or one ring during the school day. All jewellery should be unobtrusive.
 Excessive makeup is not appropriate with uniform. Acrylic nails are not permitted.
